Hi Deborah,

I'm looking for a hike leader or 2, for Saturday, September 11 from 9 am to 12 pm for a South Coast Striders hike. The whole group would start down Hidden Creek to the Observation Platform. At the Observation Platform, the group would split in 2, short and long hikers. The short hikers would head up Big Cedar to the road to Middle Creek for a 2 mile hike. The long hikers would head out the Tunnel trail to the North Creek trail for a 4 mile hike.

The main interpretation would be along Hidden Creek. There would be 6 interpretive points; an introduction at the IC, 4 stops along Hidden Creek, and a wrap-up/division of groups at the Observation Platform. This groups emphasis is on hiking, so there would be limited interpretive stops and hiking. I could either do a training hike or write up a short description for each stop.
